# **Drivers Education Policies**

Listed below are the objectives of the Drivers Education Course at USD #389 Eureka, Kansas.

#### 1. Attendance

A student must not miss more than two of the scheduled class periods or he/she will be dismissed from the class. Instructors and administration will review issues of emergency absences.

# 2. Student Eligibility

All students who are 14 years of age prior to the first day of class are eligible to enroll.

# 3. **Grading Procedure and Credit**

To be eligible for 1/4 credit in drivers' education, each student must successfully complete each classroom module with an 80%. The following grading scale will be used: 90% to 100% = A; 80% to 89% = B At any point the student does not pass a test on the third attempt he/she will be dismissed from the class.

#### 4. Make-Up Procedures

All make-up work will be completed prior to the last scheduled day of class. No incompletes will be given.

#### 5. **Testing Procedures**

No student may take more than two version A exams per day. The instructor will administer make-up tests at an arranged time.

#### 6. Time in Car

Each driver's education instructor will spend no more than eight (8) hours per day in-car supervising students. Each student must have at least four sessions of in-car, behind-the-wheel instruction. Driving instructors will develop the driving schedule in which students must attend all sessions. Missed driving time may result in the inability to successfully complete the course.

#### 7. **Transportation**

Transportation to and from the school to attend the summer course is the responsibility of the student.

### 8. **Discipline**

Due to the serious nature of the material covered and the safety of the others in the class, inappropriate student conduct may result in dismissal from the driver education program.

## 9. **Refund Policy**

The enrollment fee will immediately be sent to the state department to pay for a driver's permit and the handbook. This cannot be refunded. The remainder can be refunded until the first day of class or driving, whichever comes first. One-half refund can be obtained until the fifth day. No refunds will be made after the fifth day of instruction.
